The Carlson Park Improvement Project aims to add active recreation facilities including a playground, improved trails to the river and an ADA river lookout trail, a multiuse court, seating for family gatherings or small events, and a small parking lot with a restroom. The Carlson Park Improvement Project will connect the active park area to the existing Mad River riparian natural area with improved trails for non-motorized boating, fishing, and water access.
