A series of storms struck Northern California in mid-February to early March 2019. Many levees in the Sacramento sustained significant damage during these storms. The Central Valley Flood Protection Board is filing a Notice of Exemption using a CEQA Emergency Exemption for this site.

**Reclamation District 70, Sutter Basin North, Meridian Unit 2, Left Bank
Sacramento River**

Location: The site is located at Levee Mile 13.0 of RD 70 Meridian Unit 2 levee segment located in the Sutter Basin North system just south of the Sutter Buttes in Sutter County.

Description of Site 0544-08: This site experienced damages, including a levee slip on the landside slope approximately 60 feet long with a crack present at the top hinge point extending for over 400 feet.

Description of Work:

Site 0544-08: To repair the site, slumped material will be excavated, and the levee slope reconstructed to a 2H:1V. The combined site length is approximately 90 feet. Excavated material will be disposed of and not be reused. A 3-foot-deep and 5-foot-wide keyway would be constructed with 1H:1V side slopes. To repair the longitudinal cracking at the levee hinge, the existing material will be excavated, and the levee slope reconstructed to a 2H:1V. Existing material will be disposed of and will not be reused. The combined site length is approximately 500 feet long.
