PROJECT TITLE: Peninsula Maintenance Compound Fuel Reduction

LOCATION: Folsom Lake State Recreation Area

COUNTY: El Dorado

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

The project will establish defensible space around the maintenance compound at Peninsula Campground in Folsom Lake State Recreation Area to prevent intense and destructive wildfires and establish defensible space around the compound. Vegetation modification conducted within 100 feet of structures will be in accordance with the Department's 2009 "Guidelines for the Protection of Structures from Wildland Fire." Work will:

- Remove dead and downed branches and fell suspended dead limbs that could serve as ladder fuel;
- Remove and/or prune dead trees, shrubs or live woody vegetation with poor structural vigor;
- Trim live vegetation that comes in contact with structures; and
- Pile and burn woody materials on site on authorized burn days over the fall and winter months or chip and locally broadcast materials.
