Project Title: Debris Removal & Streambed Stabilization – Cold Stream (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0113-R2)

Project Location: The project is located in Cold Stream, in the County of Sierra, State of California; Latitude 39.5609 N, Longitude 120.3579 W; Section 30, Township 20N, Range 15E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, US Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 quad Sierraville.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0113-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to David Ostler.

The project is limited to implementing temporary Best Management Practices, installing rock slope protections, backfilling eroded voids with stone fill, covering the stone fill with gravelly sand, and planting bio-engineered willow and alder stakes, and/or seeding unvegetated areas.
