Project Title: Unbalanced Exchange of State Water Project Table A Water between San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency and Ventura County Watershed Protection District (SWPAO #19027)

Location – Specific: From the Delta to San Gorgonio Pass Water Agency's (SGPWA) turnout(s) at Reaches 4A and 4B of the California Aqueduct's East Branch Extension and Ventura County Watershed Protection District's (VCWPD) turnout(s) at Reach 30 of the California Aqueduct's West Branch.

Location – County: Riverside and Ventura Counties

Description of Activity: Under the proposed water exchange, up to 2,000 acre-feet of VCWPD's approved 2019 SWP Table A water (2019 Table A Water) will be delivered to SGPWA by December 31, 2019. This amount will be proportioned between two of VCWPD's member agencies, City of San Buenaventura (Ventura) and Casitas Municipal Water District (Casitas). Up to 1,350 acre-feet shall come from Ventura and up to 650 acre-feet shall come from Casitas.

In exchange, SGPWA will return to Ventura and Casitas, based on an exchange ratio of 2 to 1, up to 1,000 acre-feet of its future approved SWP Table A water. That is, for every acre-foot of either Ventura's and/or Casitas's 2019 Table A Water delivered to SGPWA, 50 percent of that amount will be returned to the appropriate member agency by December 31, 2029.
