Location - Specific: From the Delta to Santa Clarita Valley Water Agency's (SCVWA) turnout(s) at Reach 30 of the California Aqueduct and Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency's (AVEK) turnout(s) at Reaches 18A through 22B of the California Aqueduct.

Location - County: Los Angeles and Kern Counties

Description of Activity: Under the proposed water exchange, up to 7,500 acre-feet of SCVWA's approved 2019 SWP Table A water (2019 Table A Water) will be delivered to AVEK by December 31, 2019. In exchange, AVEK will return to SCVWA, based on an unbalance exchange ratio of 2:1, up to 3,750 acre-feet of its future approved SWP Table A water. That is, for every 2 acre-feet of SCVWA's 2019 Table A Water delivered to AVEK, 1 acre-foot will be returned by AVEK to SCVWA by December 31, 2029.
