Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed project would renovate Gavin Park to provide improved recreational amenities to the local community. Proposed improvements would be developed within the existing boundary of Gavin Park, and would include the construction of a youth baseball infield with bleachers and players benches for day-time use, a half-court basketball court with additional seating, a water fountain, and grassy areas for passive recreation. The center of the park would include playground equipment constructed for the 5-year to 12-year age group and the 2-year to 5-year age group, a new restroom, picnic shelters with benches, barbecues, and water fountains. Public art installations and a park entry sign would be constructed near the park entrance and ADA paths would connect the improvements within the park.

Reasons why project is exempt:

Class 2 consists of replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. Class 3 consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. Class 4 consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes.

Gavin Park is an existing facility with grass playing fields, playground equipment, picnic tables, and benches. Proposed playground equipment improvements are consistent with a Class 2 exemption under

Section 15302, Replacement or Reconstruction. The proposed construction of new bathrooms (360 square feet), bleachers, picnic shelters, benches, barbecues, water fountains, and public art represent new small structures and are consistent with a Class 3 exemption under Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures. The project's landscaping, baseball infield, and basketball court represent minor alterations to the existing park site and are consistent with a Class 4 exemption under Section 15304, Minor Alterations to Land.
