It was determined that an alternate disposal system within the existing footprint of the WWTP facility was feasible. Upgrades to the existing WWTP will include the following: Installation of a 20,000 gallon (10-foot diameter by 35-foot long) septic tank; installation of a 4,000 square foot leach field and associated leach lines; and connection to the existing sewer collection system (with an 8-inch influent line).
