Paul Sereno and/or Bill Pensar (Lemon Cove Sanitary District):

Caltrans has a "NO COMMENT" on the Lemon Cove Waste Water Treatment Improvement Project.

As indicated by the MND analysis:

- The project will construct an alternate disposal system <u>within the existing</u> footprint of the 2.5 acre WWTP facility to include installation of a 20,000 gallon (10-foot diameter by 35-foot long) septic tank; installation of a 4,000 square foot leach field and associated leach lines; and connection to the existing sewer collection system (with an 8-inch influent line).
- Improvements to the existing WWTP will occur within a 45-foot buffer around the existing pond and pipeline routes, totaling approximately 2.5-acres.
- The 2.5 acre site is located on the southwest side of Goodale Lane approximately 1/2 mile southwest of the State Route (SR) 198 and SR 216 intersection.
