Project Description: The applicant is requesting approval of a Development Plan permit in order to construct three warehouse buildings totaling 555,537 square feet in area. The project also includes: a minor subdivision tentative parcel map (MS19-0009), demolition of existing improvements, landscaping, off-site roadway and drainage improvements, annexation of the subject site into the West County Wastewater District, removal of 8 trees, grading of approximately 168,000 cubic yards of soil (37,000 cut and 131,000 fill) and soil remediation as needed due to the previous agricultural uses on site.
