**Project Title:** Murphy Park Clean-up of Angels Creek (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0269-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Angels Creek, in the County of Calaveras, State of California; Latitude 38.13638, Longitude -120.46448; or 516 Algiers Street, Murphys, CA, 95247; or Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 066-001-026-000 and 066-001-028-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-00269-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Patrick Martin representing Calaveras County Administration Department.

The project is limited to the removal of approximately 3200 square feet of vegetation along Angels Creek and the hand removal of trash and debris along the banks to restore normal flows to the creek.
