Project Location: The project is located at San Leandro Creek, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.84142, Longitude -122.186976; Assessor's Parcel Number 257-020-011.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0211-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to East Bay Regional Park District.

The project will restore portions of the Upper San Leandro Creek stream channel, remove an existing corrugated metal culvert and failing concrete sack headwall, and install a clear span arch bridge.
