Project Title: Jacobson Pier (Lake Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0138-R2)

Project Location: The project is located on Donner Lake at 14578 South Shore Drive, Truckee, Nevada County, State of California; Latitude 39.317805, Longitude -120.269263; APN 017-371-020.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0138-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code.

The project is limited to the modification to an existing private pier and boathouse. The boathouse and a portion of the boathouse will be removed (approximately 4 cubic yards), and the pier expansion will be approximately 25' x 19', for a total of 461 sq. feet. There will be 11 new pilings, which are 8-3/4" diameter. The remainder of the pier framing will be wooden beams and joists. The decking will be Trex composite decking.
