PROJECT TITLE: Donner Nature Loop Trail Update

LOCATION: Donner Memorial State Park

COUNTY: Placer and Nevada

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Install seven (7) new number posts on the Nature Loop Trail at Donner Memorial State Park to replace the (already removed) old posts as well as match the new Nature Loop Trail brochure. Completion of this work will restore an interpretive element to the Nature Loop Trail, an accessible, 1/2 mile long path through the historic and meadow area of the park. Work will:

- Excavate five (5) 30" deep x 8" wide holes and install one (1) 4" x 4" x 5' post in each hole;
- Pour cement, as needed, to secure each post;
- If necessary, attach two (2) of the number posts to the existing boardwalk and attach with appropriate hardware;
- Use appropriate hardware to attach metal number signs to the posts and trim any extending bolts;
- Attach a plastic brochure box to sign #1.
