NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Title: Letter of Non-Objection to enter onto State sovereign land adjacent to Sanchez Channel, location at and adjacent to 410 Airport Boulevard in Burlingame, San Mateo County

Location: Sovereign lands along Sanchez Channel adjacent to 410 Airport Boulevard in the city of Burlingame, San Mateo County.

Description: Permission to enter State sovereign land to conduct work associated with the construction of a pedestrian bridge within the right-of-way of Airport Boulevard. Work within State land includes removing the Sherman Parking lot sign, removing and replacing concrete sidewalks and asphalt as part of the Bay Trail, removing and replacing the existing cyclone fence and k-rail barricades, removing and replacing the existing cyclone gate, and relocating an electronic transformer from the Airport Boulevard right-of-way onto State land property.
