Project Title: Hesperia Commerce Center II (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit No. 2081-2021-038-06 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): The project is located at the northwest quadrant of the intersection of U.S. Highway 395 and Phelan Road/Main Street within the City of Hesperia, San Bernardino County. Additional linear segments occur along Yucca Terrace Drive, U.S. Highway 395, Phelan Road, Los Banos Avenue and Sultana Street.

Project Description: This proposed project involves the construction of three industrial/warehouse buildings with associated office spaces, surface parking, loading areas, and stormwater drainage. Off-site utilities (including a sewer line and water line) and roadway improvements to accommodate the project will also be constructed.

The Project will result in impacts to 202.14 acres of western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*) habitat; the Project will permanently remove 202.14 acres of western Joshua tree habitat. The project is expected to result in incidental take of western Joshua tree, which is designated as a candidate threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act.
