PROJECT TITLE & FILE NUMBER: Ball Road Storm Water Improvements Project

PROJECT LOCATION - Specific: The Ball Road Storm Water Improvements Project are from Ball Road to the Carbon Creek Channel, along Western Avenue, Sunview Drive and OCTA's Right of Way from Sunview Drive until Carbon Creek Channel, as shown on the attached map.

PROJECT LOCATION - City/County: City of Anaheim, Orange County, California

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City proposes to install a storm water diversion junction structure along Ball Road at Western Avenue and just west of Knott Avenue, as well as a retention/detention system within the abandoned rail line owned by OCTA. This system will divert storm water flow from the main storm line on Ball Road, and draw storm water south along Western Avenue and then west along Sunview Drive, until it reaches the abandoned rail line. The infiltration system will allow the storm water to percolate into the ground water, between Sunview Drive and Ball Road.
