The Project proposes a total of 782 residential units, including 66 studio apartments, 417 one-bedroom apartments, 284 two-bedroom, and 15 three-bedroom apartments. Of the 782 residential units proposed by the Project, the Project would provide a total of 141 affordable housing units (87 Extremely Low Income, and 37 Low Income units). The units range in size from 576 square feet (studio) to 1,472 square feet (three-bedroom apartment).
