PROJECT TITLE: District Office Water Well

LOCATION: Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area **COUNTY:** Alameda

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Project will drill test hole(s) to evaluate site feasibility for the installation of a new water well at Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area to replace an existing well with poor water quality. Work will:

- Use a skid steer to clear an approximately 1,000 sq. ft. area around the drill site;
- Use a truck mounted auger to drill up to three (3) 8" diameter by 400' deep test holes to determine water availability and quality; and
- If a test hole result is successful, additional work will widen the top 60' of the hole to 12" in diameter and the lower portion (past 60') up to 10" in diameter to accommodate well equipment installation.
