SUBJECT: *Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108*

Project Title: Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0176-R2 "Village" THP

The project is located in Mill Creek and various unnamed tributaries of the North Fork Stanislaus River, in Calaveras County, State of California. The projects are located in the Dorrington and Boards Crossing U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) maps, Township 5N, Range 15E, Sections 12, 13, 14, 23, and 24, Township 5N, Range 16E, Sections 5, 6, 7, and 8, and Township 6N, Range 16E, Sections 31 and 32; Mount Diablo base and meridian.

The project is limited to water drafting from three existing sites, construction and use of one new water drafting site, removal of one permanent crossing followed by construction of a temporary crossing, maintenance of one existing crossing, reconstruction of one permanent crossing, and construction of three temporary skid trail crossings. Further information can be found in the THP 4-19-00007-CAL.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
