The Project would replace the existing Crittenden Lane Trailhead with a 280-foot-long, 12-foot-wide trailhead featuring 2-footwide shoulders, driveway improvements at the Crittenden Lane cul-de-sac, signage and striping improvements, and ADAcompliant gradients supported by a combination of retaining walls and fill slopes. Portions of the new trailhead facility would be relocated just north of the existing trailhead. However, the new trailhead would intersect Stevens Creek Trail at the same location as the existing trailhead. The Project does not propose new lighting features. In total, the Project footprint is approximately 12,000 square feet.
