Project Location (include county): Arroyo Seco Creek. It is located at State Route (SR) 79 at Post Mile (PM) 9.3 located south of Vail lake. Project Description: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace Arroyo Seco Bridge and upgrade Bridge Rails and Approach Rail at Blue Ridge Wash Box Culvert Bridge. The project will affect 0.14 acres of resources subject to Fish and Game Code section 1600 *et seq.* and will mitigate with 0.14 credits from a CDFW-approved bank.
