PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The goal of this project is to install "trail condition" display cases at Big Basin Redwoods State Park, Castle Rock State Park, and Portola Redwoods State Park. The biggest benefit of this project, is that it will provide park users with an opportunity to get up date information regarding trail/park conditions. This should cut down on visitor confusion, give CDPR another avenue to provide the public with information, and potentially reduce lost hikers.

The 48"X30"X3" display cases will each be secured in place with two 4"X4"posts that will be buried approximately 36" in the ground, with approximately 72" above ground. The posts will be secured with a road base filler. Only hand tools will be used for the project and there will be no disruption to park/visitor activities.

The board at Big Basin will be located at the entrance of the campfire center, near Big Basin Park Headquarters. It will be right of the trail leading to the Camp Fire Center and will be to the left of the existing map board. It will not impact physical or visual access to the Campfire Center.

The board at Portola Redwoods State Park will be located to the left of the Visitor Center. It will be left of the existing map board and should not negatively impact the visual appeal and park feel of the Visitor Center.

Two boards will be placed at Castle Rock State Park. The first one will be located directly across from the kiosk, at the park's Kirkwood entrance. It will be left of the existing map board and will not obscure views of the native grass area. The second Castle Rock location will be at the Overflow Lot, placed to the left of the existing map board and should not negatively impact the visual appeal and park feel of the Overflow lot trail head.

No plant life will be removed for the project and all four of the project areas are already heavily impacted by park visitors.




Proposed location of the sign board.






Proposed location of the sign board with rendering.






