PROJECT TITLE: Park-wide Culvert Repairs

LOCATION: Angel Island State Park

COUNTY: Marin

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Repair historic concrete culverts and nonhistoric steel culverts as necessary throughout Angel Island State Park to protect the park roads and infrastructure as well as reduce impacts to resources. Work will occur along the Perimeter Road, along the Fire Road and in the Cove. Based on conditions at each culvert, work will entail a combination of the following:

For Concrete culverts:

- Clear culverts of accumulated debris;
- Clean out and patch small cracks or holes with concrete; and/or
- Build wood forms and pour new wire mesh reinforced concrete to match the existing contour of the repaired culvert.

For Steel culverts:

- · Clear culverts of accumulated debris;
- For straight culverts, line the existing culverts; and/or
- For culverts that can't be lined, excavate and repair or replace the culverts with new steel culverts.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels, included as "road repairs" in the Department of Parks and Recreation's list of exempt activities, in accordance with CCR § 15300.4, the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced; and the minor public or private alteration in the condition of land which does not involve the removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
