Project Title: JDSF Road 200 Stream Crossings (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0595-R1)

**Project Location:** The project is approximately 14 miles east-southeast of Fort Bragg, on Forest Road 200, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Sections 19, 30, 31, 32, Township 18N, Range 15W; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Northspur, Calif. U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0595-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, represented by Mike Powers.

The project is limited to 15 encroachments, all of which are culvert replacements or new installations. Culverts will be sized to accommodate 100-year flow, including sediment load and debris, and will be installed to current standards.
