REASONS PROJECT IS EXEMPT

This project consists of relocating the Alma Helitack Base by leasing existing hanger space, apparatus bay and two modular office buildings within an existing operational airfield. Two new modular buildings will be constructed in 2020 to accommodate the relocation and expansion of operations.

The leasing of existing structures falls under 14 CCR §15301: Existing Facilities, Class 1. Consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The two new modular buildings fall under 14 CCR §15303: New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures, Class 3. Consists of the construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure.

Field review by CAL FIRE staff confirmed that no exceptions apply that would preclude the use of a notice of exemption for this project. The Department has concluded that no significant environmental impact would occur to aesthetics, agriculture and forestland or timberland, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use planning, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services, recreation, transportation or traffic, or to utilities and service systems.
