NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

PROJECT TITLE: Tuolumne Road Improvement Project

PROJECT PROPONENT: Tuolumne County Department of Public Works

LOCATION: The project boundaries are on Tuolumne Road from Lambert Lake Road to Terrace Drive. Portions of Sections 4 and 5, Township 1 North, Range 15 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian. Within Supervisorial District 4.

COUNTY: Tuolumne

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of the installation of a 2-way left turn lane with 8-foot paved shoulders. Cuts will be made into the adjacent hillside and retaining walls installed to accommodate the widening of the road. Retaining walls and fill will also be placed on the downhill side of the road at some locations to accommodate the widening. Excess soil will be disposed of in a manner consistent with the approved Storm Water Pollution Control Plan and may be transported offsite for use as fill. Staging of construction equipment will be at the Terrace Drive right-of-way at the south end of Kodiak Court, or the paved surface adjacent to the Junction Shopping Center. The project also consists of the rehabilitation or replacement of drainage features on Tuolumne Road to accommodate the widening. No permanent right-of-way acquisitions are anticipated. This project is to improve public safety of motorists for an approximate length of 2,800 feet of Tuolumne Road.
