Project Title: Greeley Hill Community Fuelbreak

Project Location - County/Specific: Project is located in Mariposa County on private lands along Smith Station Road - a County-maintained road - from the Tuolumne County line south to its intersection with Greeley Hill Road. Specifically, fuels reduction work will be conducted roughly within 200-foot distance of this County-maintained road threatened by dead or dying trees and highly-flammable ladder fuels.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The Mariposa County Fire Safe Council's Greeley Hill Community Fuelbreak project is a Tree Mortality Hazard Mitigation Project in Tier 1 High Hazard zones on State Responsibility Area lands within Mariposa County. The work is critical to meet the public safety and tree disposal needs stemming from widespread tree mortality in the southern Sierra Nevada, and to complete the program of work (2016 Mariposa County Tree Mortality Hazard Mitigation Project) with the co-benefits that include protecting infrastructure and increasing public safety from debris flows and flooding damage due to high levels of biomass on erosive, fire damaged soils. The project also protects communities located within the Wildland Urban Interface.

The mitigation activities are needed based on a high density of dead and dying trees and highly-flammable ladder fuels which threaten powerlines, roads and evacuation corridors, critical community infrastructure and other existing structures. The project will benefit Mariposa County residents and visitors, Mariposa County business owners, the U.S. Forest Service, CAL FIRE and all emergency responders. The purpose of this project is to interrupt potential wildfire behavior by reducing the rate of spread and intensity of fire and to provide improved opportunities for fire crews to stop the fire spread. The project will provide an evacuation route for residents as well as a vital ingress-egress route for first responders under exigent circumstances and from which to make a fire defensible stand. The project will reduce the amount of hazardous fuels on approximately 25 acres of private land adjacent to County roads in the Wildland-Urban Interface area east of Greeley Hill, and is designed to protect the communities and critical infrastructure while also reducing the potential for fires to spread from developed areas. The dead or dying trees included in this project are not healthy, mature or scenic trees based on their current condition. Dead or dying trees will be felled in a controlled manner to reduce hazards. Ladder fuels (brush, small trees) will be hand masticated or mechanically masticated as slopes/accessibility allow.
