The proposed changes to the HBFC campus include the removal of four residential buildings totaling 51,694 \pm sq. ft., which currently provide 80 beds. These buildings will be replaced by two 2-story residential buildings, each providing 46 beds for a total of 92 beds. Each will consists of 30,935 \pm sq. ft. & have an overall height of 30 \pm feet . The construction of a new one-story, 22,748 \pm square foot day-treatment building is also proposed to be located on a currently vacant and undeveloped portion of the campus which will house 44 day treatment patients, associated support space, and 6,400 square feet of administrative space including a computer lab and lecture hall. The project also proposes limited modifications to the existing site plan.
