Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The project consists of the design and construction of wellhead treatment for Trichloropropane (TCP) removal using granular activated carbon (GAC) treatment at Wells 4, 6, and 7, and a 12" pipeline to connect Well 5 to the Well 6 site for future treatment. The project also includes installing backwash tanks, site-work, electrical upgrades, an emergency standby generator at Site 4, chlorination facilities, well redevelopment, and two new water lubricated turbine pumps. New facilities at Well 4 and 6 sites will be contained within the existing well site (except for the pipeline from site 5 to site 6, which will be buried within public right of way). New facilities at Well 7 site will be located on the adjoining Del Rey CSD-owned property. Maximum depth of excavation will be 3 feet.
