Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

DWR will have a Contractor install Electrical Vehicle (EV) Charging stations. Site preparation will include removal of existing landscape from project footprint. Electrical conduit installation will be trenched and routed from designated power source to new concrete pad. New pad construction and existing lot will be modified to adopt to new ADA regulations. Charging station foundation will be six by nine feet to support electrical disconnect, transformer and panel board. There will be five EV chargers installed. Staging will be on existing paved parking lot and roadways. All work will be within DWR right-of-way.
