Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has issued Amendment #1 to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2020-0219-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

Amendment #1 changes the Project Description and Project Impacts to include the construction of a retaining/stabilization structure on the bank of North Honcut Creek and additional permanent riparian impacts resulting from Project activities. In addition, the mitigation requirement was increased to account for the increased permanent riparian impacts.
