## **Encroachment Permit**

It appears some of the work locations are in the vicinity of State right-of-way (ROW), specifically Interstate 680, State Route (SR) 242, SR 24, and SR 4 in Contra Costa County. Please be advised that any work or traffic control that encroaches onto the State ROW requires a Caltrans-issued encroachment permit. To obtain an encroachment permit, a completed encroachment permit application, environmental documentation, six (6) sets of plans clearly indicating the State ROW, and six (6) copies of signed, dated and stamped (include stamp expiration date) traffic control plans must be submitted to: Office of Encroachment Permits, California DOT, District 4, P.O. Box 23660, Oakland, CA 94623-0660.
