


PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration and Notice of a Proposed Section 4(f) *De Minimis* Determination for the Last Chance Grade Phase 2B Geotechnical Investigation

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to conduct a geotechnical investigation in support of the Last Chance Grade Permanent Restoration Project, located on U.S. Highway 101 between postmiles 12.0 and 15.5 in Del Norte County. The purpose of the geotechnical investigation is to characterize the geology within the project area and along potential roadway alignments. The characterization would occur through the analysis of soil and rock samples, groundwater data, and measurements of slope movement. The information is needed to evaluate and identify geotechnically critical sites, including locations of potential bridge abutments and tunnel portals.



WHAT IS AVAILABLE

Caltrans has prepared a draft Initial Study (IS) with a proposed Negative Declaration (ND) and a proposed Section 4(f) *De Minimis* Determination (Appendix D of IS). The document is available for review beginning December 17, 2019 at the following locations:
