Project Location – City: Pismo BeachProject Location – County: San Luis ObispoDescription of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: In order to help ensure thatPismo State Beach continues to provide high quality habitat for monarch butterflies, the XercesSociety for Invertebrate Conservation, in coordination with staff from California Department ofParks and Recreation, has prepared a 5-year site management plan to better plan and implementmanagement actions which support overwintering monarchs in both the short and long-termduration.The site management plan includes the goals of the plan, site history and description,plan development, tree management, nectar management, outreach and education, managementrecommendations, monitoring, next steps and plan implementation.In addition to the sitemanagement plan, up to 1000 linear feet of shallow trenching may be required to extend the waterconnections under foot paths in the grove so that the newly planted trees can be properly irrigated.An archeological monitor will be present during any ground disturbing work associated with themanagement plan and further irrigation work.
