# PURPOSE:

The purpose of this project is to ensure Caltrans can provide accurate and timely data for traffic and travel conditions including construction activities, collisions, and weather-related incidents by installing a wireless communication system backbone, upgrading existing traffic volume sensors to real-time traffic monitoring stations, and making related improvements to Intelligent Transportation System elements.

#### NEED

The need of this project arose because traffic information is currently collected via dial-up telephone lines and DSL connections. These connections are sometimes unreliable, and they limit the transfer of information due to limited bandwidth availability. Some traffic data is obtained by installing temporary traffic volume collection systems that expose field workers to traffic during installation. This project is needed to improve system reliability for providing traffic information to highway system users.

### THE SCOPE OF WORK INCLUDES:

# Location 1: SR 20 PM 7.76

Installation of new radio antenna and camera on existing pole and battery backup system on existing cabinet, as well as replacement of existing changeable message sign (CMS) and controller with new models. Cold planing and overlaying of existing maintenance vehicle pullout (MVP) will be necessary.

#### Location 2: SR 20 PM 12.20

Installation of new 35' pole, CMS, radio antenna, camera, cabinet and concrete pad, 24" reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) culvert, and paved MVP with supported embankment.

### Location 3: SR 20 PM 19.28

Installation of new 35' pole, radio antenna, camera, cabinet and concrete pad, count station, and MVP.

# Location 4: SR 29 PM 22.19

Installation of new 35' Pole, CMS, cabinet, MVP with supported embankment, guardrail, and count station. Trenching will be necessary from the newly acquired PG&E service source to the MVP to provide power for new equipment.

# Location 5 State Furnished Materials (SFM): SR 29 PM 38.6

Installation of new count station using existing cabinet at location. An encroachment permit will be obtained for work on Highland Springs Road.

# Location 6 SFM: SR 29 PM 44.56

Installation of new cabinet adjacent to existing cabinet, concrete pad, 35' pole, CMS, radio antenna, and camera. Cold planing and repaving of existing MVP will be necessary, and new trenching may be required if unable to use existing conduit.

# Location 7 SFM: SR 175 PM 0.3

Installation of new 35' pole, radio antenna, camera, cabinet, and count station. Trenching between the cabinet and pole will be necessary, as will construction of an MVP and required supportive embankment. To provide service to this location, a temporary construction easement (TCE) will be required to intercept the existing PG&E service line, a new power pole with the attached line will be placed in the Caltrans Right-of-Way, and trenching will occur from the new pole to the proposed cabinet.

### Location 8 SFM: US 101 PM 8.4

Install 35' pole, radio antenna, and CMS. Trenching will be required to install conduit from new pole to existing service pull-box and it will be necessary to run conductors from PG&E service box to existing cabinet. Cold planing of existing MVP and placement of 0.3' of hot mix asphalt (HMA) will also be required.

# Location 9 SFM: SR 29 PM 27.89

Mounting of radio antenna and camera on existing signal pole and battery backup system cabinet on existing cabinet.

### Location 10 SFM: SR 29 PM 52.54

Mounting of new closed-circuit television system and radio antenna on existing equipment.

## Location 11 SFM: SR 53 PM 1.47

Mounting of new closed-circuit television system and radio antenna on existing equipment. (Continued on next page)
