Project Title: Sykes Timber Harvest Plan 1-19-00095 SCR "Sykes" (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0272-R3)

Project Location: The project is located in Santa Cruz County, approximately 3 miles NW of Boulder Creek; Sections 21 & 22, Township 10N, Range 14W, USGS Quad Stewarts Point, Mt. Diablo base and meridian.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0272-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, David Van Lennep.

The project is limited to a permanent culvert replacement over an unnamed Class III watercourse at map point RX9, and a permanent culvert installation over an unnamed Class III watercourse at map point RX10.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on January 13, 2020, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
