**Project Location (include county):** The Project is within an unnamed stream, a tributary to the Santa Margarita River, along Avenida Del Oro, in the County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33. 496785°, Longitude - 117.198628°.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0075-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Steve Hopkins.

The Project is limited to the construction and associated grading of a single arched culvert containing a 66" X 51" diameter pipe, approximately 20 feet long, along with associated concrete headwall. The culvert will support a stream crossing for utility access. The proposed Project also includes limited placement of rock rip rap on both sides of the channel adjacent to the concrete headwall to provide erosion control.
