NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY (NOA) OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR) FOR THE MOUNTAIN VIEW HIGH SCHOOL LIGHTS AND PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM PROJECT (SCH# 2020010296) AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Project Description: The proposed project is the installation and operation of field lights and an upgraded public address (PA) system at the MVHS track and athletic field. The project proposes to install four pole-mounted field lights and 12 speakers on the east and west sides of the field. The field lights would reach 90 feet in height and the speakers would range from 12 to 18 feet in height. The field lights would provide for safe and flexible nighttime use of the field for various sporting and marching band activities, including practices and games. The field lights would also allow for evening special events, such as commencement exercises. A select number of nighttime events would include the use of the PA system. The PA system will also be used for sporting events, marching band, and school activities during daytime hours. The use of the stadium field lights and public address system would be guided by the Mountain View Los Altos High School District's (District) Board Policy 7325 and Administrative Regulations 7325.

Location: The project is located at the southwest corner of the Mountain View High School campus at 3535 Truman Avenue, Mountain View, CA 94040 (see Figure 1 next page).

The proposed project will have potentially significant environmental effects on Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils and Hazardous Materials. The California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires this notice to disclose whether any listed toxic sites are present at the project location. The project site is not listed on any toxic sites databases.
