**PROJECT TITLE:** Folsom Powerhouse Interpretive Signs Replacement

**LOCATION:** Folsom Powerhouse State Historic Park **COUNTY:** Sacramento

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: Install 7-8 interpretive panels (of varying sizes) and support stanchions inside and outside the historic core of the Folsom Powerhouse State Historic Park to replace existing interpretive signage. New interpretive panels will be as follows:

- Panels 1-6 will be approximately 20" X 3", mounted on a single post installed in concrete in an 8" diameter by 24" deep hole;
- Panel seven (7) will be 24" X 48", mounted on two (2) 2" X 4" posts installed in concrete in an 8" diameter by 30" deep hole; and
- Panel eight (8) will be 36" X 48", mounted on two (2) 2" X 4" posts installed in concrete in an 8" diameter by 36" deep.

Holes will be excavated by hand or with an auger, depending on soil conditions. The existing single post stanchions will be removed as part of the project.
