Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Cloverdale Creek at 509 North Cloverdale Boulevard, Cloverdale, in the County of Sonoma.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0109-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Cloverdale Unified Union School District.

The project includes the replacement of an existing dirt track and grass field with a new synthetic track and turf field as part of a larger stadium project.
