


NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Notice is hereby given that the public agency named below has completed an Initial Study of the following described project at the following location:	
Public Agency:	City of Riverside Public Works Department
Project Name:	Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Installation Project
Project Description:	The Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Installation Project (the Project) consists of construction and operation of facilities (sewer pipeline, Krameria sewage lift station, and force main) to provide sewer service to properties along Van Buren Boulevard and to a proposed residential development located north of Van Buren Boulevard, on property northwesterly of the intersection of Iris Avenue and Chicago Avenue. The Project also includes construction of an emergency storage tank at the City's existing Wood Road Lift Station, as well as demolition and removal of the City's existing MLK1 Lift Station. The Project is described in additional detail in the Initial Study, a copy of which is available for review at the location described below.
Project Location – Identify street address and cross streets or attach a map showing project site (preferably a USGS 15' or 7 1/2' topographical map identified by quadrangle name):	The sewer and force main pipelines are located within Van Buren Boulevard (from King Street to Wood Road) and within Washington Street (from Van Buren Boulevard to Krameria Avenue). The Krameria Lift Station is located on a parcel northeasterly of the intersection of Washington Street and Krameria Avenue. The Wood Road Lift Station is located at 7802 Wood Road, and the MLK1 Lift Station is located at 18601 Van Buren Boulevard. All Project facilities are located in the City of Riverside and nearby unincorporated areas in Riverside County, California.
This Initial Study was completed in accordance with California's Guidelines for Implementing the California Environmental Quality Act. This Initial Study was undertaken for the purpose of deciding whether the project may have a significant effect on the environment. On the basis of such Initial Study, the Lead Agency's Staff has concluded that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment, and has therefore prepared a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration. The Initial Study reflects the independent judgment of the Lead Agency.

If the Lead Agency finds that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment, it may adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration. This means that the Lead Agency may proceed to consider the project without the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report.
