Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Van Buren Boulevard Sewer Installation Project (the Project) consists of construction and operation of facilities (sewer pipeline, Krameria sewage lift station, and force main) to provide sewer service to properties along Van Buren Boulevard and to a proposed residential development located north of Van Buren Boulevard, on property northwesterly of the intersection of Iris Avenue and Chicago Avenue. The Project also includes construction of an emergency storage tank at the City's existing Wood Road Lift Station, as well as demolition and removal of the City's existing MLK1 Lift Station.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The potentially significant effects of the project involve burrowing owls, least Bell's vireo, nesting birds, riparian resources, cultural resources, noise, paleontological resources, and tribal cultural resources. Mitigation measures that will avoid or reduce the potentially significant impacts have been incorporated into the project and are set forth in the project's Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, which is attached to the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for the project.

If applicable, describe any of the project's areas of controversy known to the Lead Agency, including issues raised by agencies and the public.

There are no areas of controversy associated with the project. The Lead Agency is currently consulting with several local Native American tribes (pursuant to AB 52). No significant impacts to tribal cultural resources have been identified at this time.
