Project Location (include county): The Project is located at the Tisdale Bypass, in the County of Sutter County, State of California; Latitude 39.025417, Longitude -121.820779 to Latitude 39.026290, Longitude -121.746470 and Latitude 39.029518, Longitude -121.790883.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0319-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Water Resources, as represented by Mitra Emami.

The Project consists of the use of heavy construction equipment to remove sediment from the Tisdale Bypass. The Project involves staging and mobilizing equipment, and removal of sediment from the Bypass.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 04/07/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
