This is in response to the letter the Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received on March 7, 2019 regarding the request for Surface Transportation Assistance Act (STAA) Terminal Access via the I-580/Mountain House Parkway (International Parkway) interchange for the Terminal located at 16900 W. Schulte Road, Tracy, CA, in San Joaquin County.

The I-580/Mountain House Parkway (International Parkway) interchange is already designated for STAA trucks within Caltrans' jurisdiction; therefore, no analysis of the interchange will be necessary. Caltrans awaits the results of the analysis, within the local jurisdiction, and written confirmation that the proposed STAA TA route meets all geometric criteria. In addition, Caltrans will need written confirmation that the terminal will provide 24/7 truck turnaround.
