The public review period begins on January 22, 2020, and ends on February 21, 2020. INITIAL STUDIES PROPOSED AS NEGATIVE DECLARATIONS OR MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATIONS:

- 1. Development Code Text Change 668.15, Conditional Use Permit No. 16-04, Tentative Parcel Map No. 16-02 (Lemoore Cooler, LLC)** - The applicant proposes to 1) add battery storage facilities within one mile of an existing public utility substation as an allowed use within agriculturally zoned districts provided approval of a conditional use permit 2) construct, install and operate a DC battery energy storage facility and 3) subdivide the 20 acre parcel into two parcels (5 acres and 15 acres). The proposed DC battery energy storage facility is to be located at 16885 25th Avenue, Lemoore, CA, Assessor's Parcel Numbers 024-190-069.

The Kings County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider the environmental document for the proposed project that is listed above. The public hearing will be held on Monday, April 6, 2020 at 7:00 P.M., in the Kings County Board of Supervisors Chambers, in the Administrative Building No. 1, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W. Lacey Blvd., Hanford, California. Pursuant to California Government Code Section 65009, subdivision (b), if you challenge Conditional Use Permit No. 17-06 in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Kings County Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing. Interested parties are invited to appear and present evidence or make statements of fact regarding the proposed projects.
