


Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration Study Results Available Changes Proposed for Route 108 Do you want a public hearing on changes proposed for Route 108?

What's Being Planned:

The California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) is considering the "108 Thin Blanket II" project, which proposes to rehabilitate the pavement by constructing a thin blanket overlay on SR 108 from the Tuolumne/Mono County line to 5.3 miles west of US Route 395.



Why This Ad: CALTRANS has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called a proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Initial Study. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the report, its availability for you to read and offer comments, and to offer the opportunity for a public hearing.
