Reclamation District (RD) 2091 is proposing levee repair construction to address seepage and boil damage on the San Joaquin River at five Levee Mile locations in Stanislaus County that threaten the stability of the existing levee. The RD2091 Levee Repair Project will repair seepage and stability issues at the five sites which total approximately 11,038 feet.
