Project Location: The project is located at Stanislaus River, in the County of Calaveras, State of California; Latitude 38.068658, Longitude -120.538344 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number CAL-28548-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Angels Camp as represented by Amy Augustine.

The project is limited to the upsizing and replacing of approximately 5,446 linear feet of deteriorating sewer line. The new pipes will be up to 18-inches in diameter. The project will result in temporary impacts to bare soil, grasses, and may require some trimming of shrubs and brambles, including Himalayan blackberry (*Rubus aermeniacus*). All disturbed areas will be restored to pre-project conditions and seeded with a native seed mixture.
