**PROJECT TITLE:** WEST VALLEY WATER DISTRICT– REACTIVATION OF WELL 7 AS A POTABLE WATER SOURCE

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), as the responsible agency, will be issuing a water supply permit. West Valley Water District (District) proposes to reactivate the existing Well 7 as a potable water source to assist in meeting current water demand. Well 7 was inactivated in 2016 per District's request.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** This is to advise that the State Water Board has determined that the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act and will issue an operational drinking water supply permit for the operation of the above described project. A record of permit issuance for the project is available to the general public at the State Water Board Division of Drinking Water District office noted above.



**Reason why project is exempt:** The project is a Class 1 existing facility that will have minor alterations of existing public structures by providing a potable water system to District's customers.
